

<u>Carlton Keighley - Year 6 Transition Day</u>

Dear Parent/Carer,

You will probably have seen an announcement in the media that there is further industrial action (strikes) from some teaching unions on the 5th July, which is also transition day for your child.

I am writing to confirm that transition day **will still go ahead** on Wednesday 5th July 2023 at Carlton Keighley.

Just a reminder of arrangements:

- Transition day will begin in school from 8:40am; please bring your child to the main school
 entrance where they will be met by a member of our transition team who will register them
 in school.
- Your child should attend wearing **their current primary school uniform** they do not need to bring a PE kit.
- The day itself will consist of some community building sessions which will introduce students
 to our core values of ambition, resilience and respect, alongside academic sessions which will
 engage students and introduce them to our approach to high quality learning.
- **Both breaktime snacks and lunch will be provided** by the school on the day; students are welcome to bring a packed lunch instead if they wish.
- The day will finish at 3:10pm. To ensure your child gets home safely, please indicate on the reply slip below whether you will be collecting your child, whether they will be walking home with an older sibling, or whether they can make their own way home.
- If you are collecting your child, please come to the front of school at 3.10 on Wednesday 5th July; you will need to give your child's name to a member of staff at the front of school and they will then be sent out to you. Please be prepared to be patient as this can take a few minutes.

In addition to transition day for students, we will be holding an information evening for parents on Thursday 6th July at 4:45pm. We would encourage all parents to attend this session with their child so we can share with all families how our school vision of excellence for all, and our core values of ambition, resilience and respect underpin our approach to learning at Carlton Keighley. We will also talk to you about how you can support your child through the transition process to ensure they settle into our school community as quickly as possible.
