
### This is how we talk in PSHE:

## Why are British Values important?

I live in North Korea; we do not get to vote for the government. Anyone who **criticises** the government is **imprisoned** and their family is often **evicted** from their house.

I live in Uganda; if I tell someone of the same gender that I like them I can be sent to prison for 10 years. I cannot be myself and feel safe.

I live in Afghanistan; because I am a female I am not allowed to go to school. If I go out without a male member of my family I will be beaten. I live in Iran; at a peaceful protest the police shot hundreds of people including 23 children some of them were my age and went to my school.

I live in America. In my state (Florida) books have been banned in school libraries which are about LGBT or characters of race.

### British Values at Carlton Keighley
