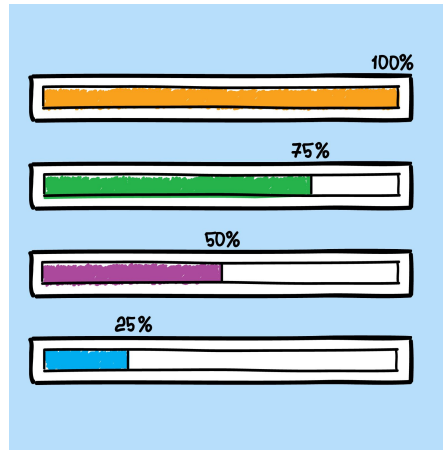

Recall & Review

1. Our local community is where we live and spend our time - for most of us this is in Keighley, it might be in different parts of the town or a mixture of places. It is around school where we all come on a daily basis.
We will look at online behaviour and safety as well - but this is our actual, physical environment.
1. After school - where are you? How do you get to school? Where are you at the weekend? Are you in your home/ around your home/ with friends or family?
2. Roads; criminal activity (i.e. hate crime/ vandalism/ substance misuse/ antisocial behaviour etc); physical wellbeing (i.e. getting cold/ sunburnt/ water safety/ getting hurt); discrimination, violence or abuse (i.e. sexism/ racism/ assault); exploitation (being used for others - either for criminal activity or sexually).

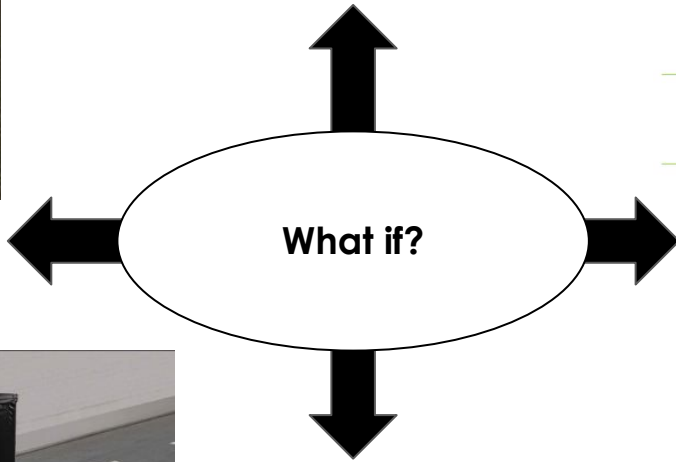

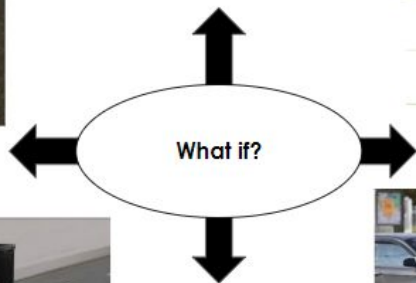

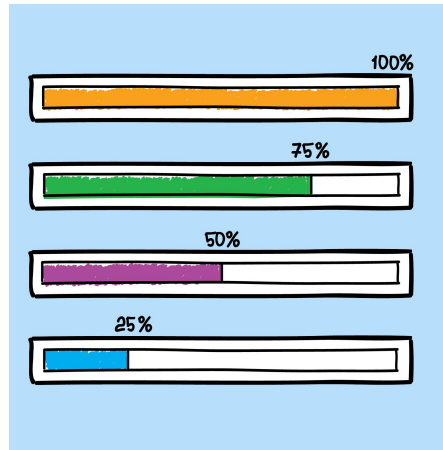

Being targeted either physically or verbally - often based in discrimination.

Being involved in or victim of any criminal activity.

Being asked to carry drugs for someone.

Being called racist/ sexist/ homophobic names.

Witnessing a stabbing.

Going swimming in the summer & getting into difficulty.

Being asked for a nude from a 19 year old.

Shouting at strangers in the bus station.

Falling over and getting a bad cut from broken glass.

Being sexually assaulted.
