To Whom It May Concern,

Consultation on Increasing the Published Admission Number (PAN) and changes to Admission Policy from 2025.

You will recall that we wrote to you back in November to discuss our intention to consult to increase the schools planned admission numbers from 150 students to 180 students, and to make some minor additions to its admission policy which will mirror the other secondary schools that are part of Carlton Academy Trust.

This decision to increase our PAN is as a result of the enhanced reputation of the school in the wider community, which means there is significantly increased demand for places. This reputation comes from the fantastic attitude and high standards our students display day-in, day-out, which showcase to people our core values of ambition, respect and resilience which underpin our community.

This consultation has now been completed, and as such, from 2025 the schools PAN will increase in line with the figures in the consultation. The school admissions policy will also be updated to reflect the changes suggested.
